OVERVIEW

A1. Schedule 5 (this Schedule) varies the Intergovernmental Agreement for a National Exchange of Criminal History Information for People Working with Children (the Agreement). Variations are specified in this Schedule. In all other respects, the Agreement remains unchanged.

Victoria and non-conviction charges The parties acknowledge that Victoria 3.5 will not exchange non-conviction charges or information relating to Victorian non-conviction charges under the Exchange. Accordingly: 3.5.1 Victoria, need not remove any barriers to its police service supplying nonconviction charges under the Exchange; 3.5.2 Victoria's police service need not supply Victorian non-conviction charges or information relating to Victorian nonconviction charges interjurisdictionally under the Exchange; and 3.5.3 other police services need not, but may, supply non-conviction charges to Victoria. (Victoria advises its police service will vet interjurisdictional criminal history information to remove interjurisdictional non-conviction charges before the information is forwarded to Victoria's participating screening units).
